Reflections From Tim

"If we walk in the light, as He is in the light."

1 John 1:7

The phrase "As He is in the light!" Is the part of what John suggests that is most challenging for us to grasp. Can we ever attain to this? Shall we ever be able to walk as clearly in the light as He is whom we call "Our Father," of whom it is written, "God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all"? (John 1:5)

*"As He is in the light" Is for us a striving for perfection, not our perfection but His. Certainly, this is the model which is set before us, for Jesus Himself said, "**Be ye perfect, even as your Father who is in heaven is perfect**"; and although we may feel that we can never rival the perfection of God, we are encouraged by Him to seek after it, and never to be satisfied until we attain it.*

An artist, as he grasps his brush, can but hope to equal the splendor Raphael or Michael Angelo, but still, if he did not have a noble ideal before his mind, he would only attain to something very average and ordinary. But what is meant by the expression that the Christian is to walk in the light as God is in the light? We conceive it to import likeness, but not degree.

As Christians we are as truly in the light, we are as heartily in the light, we are as sincerely in the light, as honestly in the light, as He is in the light, but not simply by acclimation, it is only as he says, "If we walk in the light..." This is suggestive of a choice we make and attain to, a striving to be as He is where He Is.

I cannot reside in the sun directly, it is too bright a place for my residence, but I can walk in the light of the sun; I cannot be God personified but I can walk in His light and attain to that perfection of purity and truth which belongs to the Lord of hosts by nature as the infinitely good, and the only way that I be as He is and do as He does is by setting the Lord always before me, and striving, by the help of the indwelling Spirit, after conformity to His image, to attain to His light.

We are to have the same light, and are as truly to have it and walk in it as God does.
