### Reflections From Tim

## *Listen To His Promptings*

### **Read; Acts 16:6-10;**

This portion of the text is commonly called “The Macedonian Call” and for good reason,. From this we are given a picture of God’s deliberate and strategic leadership of Paul in prompting and directing him to carry the Gospel to the right place at the right time helping us to understand how the Lord will prompt us to move when it’s His time to move.

A preacher once told of an interesting experience which happened one Friday, his weekly day of rest. He said “*The Holy Spirit prompted me to call a young single mother in our community to see if her car had been repaired. I had some reservations about making the call, but I obeyed.*”

*Little did I know”, he continues, “that my obedience would help save her life. She said later: “Friday at work I was planning on taking my life; but in a time of need, I believe God was there for me. He had the preacher call me, and just by listening to his voice, I knew that God loved me.”*

The apostle Paul must have had reservations when the Holy Spirit prompted him and his team not to go into the provinces of Asia and Bithynia. Instead, they heard the Spirit's call to go into Macedonia to preach the good news. In each situation, they obeyed the Spirit's promptings. As a result, Paul and his team were instrumental in helping that city through the establishment of the Church in Philippi (Acts 16:11-15).

As Christians we are blessed with the power of the Holy Spirit dwelling in us (Eph. 2:22), our desire motivated by the Spirit is to please Him. We must not grieve the Holy Spirit (Eph. 4:30) by ignoring His gentle promptings.

When we obey Him, we may then be used by God to lead someone to Christ, to disciple, or even to help save somebody's life. Make the right choice: Obey the Spirit's voice.
