## Reflections From Tim

*Phil 4:4-14;-1 Corinthians 10:31;*

In the reading of these two passages of scripture we find an assurance that is second to none. When taken in faith genuine and trust unequalled we find encouragement to strive for that which without Gods leadership would be unthinkable. Through which also we learn that...

### ***“Me” and GOD make a Majority of ONE !***

These words are echoed in the very nature of the heart of every true Child of God, as we articulate the depth of our faith in our creator.

Blaise Pascal, You may have heard of him he was the brilliant 17th-century intellectual, who made significant contributions in the fields of science and mathematics. He established the groundwork for the development of mechanical calculators and modern hydraulic operations.

As a young man, Pascal had a profound experience that changed his life. This life-changing experience motivated him to refocus his study from science and math to theology.

Pascal wrote a remarkable prayer that won the praise and admiration of many who were moved by it in facing the many tasks and challenges of life. He prayed: *“Lord, help me to do great things as though they were little, since I do them with Your power; and little things as though they were great, since I do them in Your name.”*

Pascal’s supplication is akin to the more profound words written by the Apostle Paul when he said, ***“I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me” (Phil. 4:13)***

Paul, further admonishes us that ***“whatever you do, do all to the glory of God” (1 Cor. 10:31)***. These admonitions are to encourage us to depend upon God for His power and to view every act as important, since it will reflect on His glory.

The next time you face a large undertaking a huge task, remember that God is your strength. And when you encounter a seemingly insignificant one, determine to do it with excellence to the glory of God. Expect great things from God; attempt great things for God. When you’re backs against wall and the odds seem not in your favor, remember... **you and God make a majority**. There is no task so great that you and God together can’t accomplish. No enemies so strong that you and God can’t defeat them.
